

University of Michigan Press Contributor's Agreement

Dear _____ ("you" or "your"):

The Regents of the University of Michigan, acting through their Press ("we" or "us"), are pleased to have the privilege of publishing your contribution, _____, to a volume currently entitled _____ ("Work"), to be edited by _____ ("Editor(s)").

The following terms describe our shared understanding.

1. We are undertaking to publish the Work, of which you are author of one or more parts. You grant us (and third parties we authorize) a worldwide license in perpetuity to use, reproduce, distribute, publicly perform and display, publish, and make derivative uses of the contribution in any medium. You also authorize us to use your name and biographical information in association with the Work and/or contribution and to register the Work with the U.S. Copyright Office.
2. You agree not to make public uses of the contribution until one year after we publish the Work. After that embargo period, you agree to properly credit us (including the Digital Object Identifier we will provide you) as the source of first publication in any public uses you make (or authorize others to make) of the contribution. During the embargo period, you may distribute your contribution to students in your courses and display portions of your contribution during presentations.
3. You warrant that you are the author and copyright holder of your contribution and that it contains no matter that is plagiarized, defamatory, or otherwise in violation of law or of the rights of others. To the extent that you use third-party copyrighted materials in the contribution, you agree to obtain necessary permission in writing and to include that permission with your contribution when you send it to the Editor(s). If you are making fair uses, other than short quotations, please notify the Editor(s) in writing of the uses you are making.
4. You will work cooperatively with the Editor(s) to meet reasonable deadlines. You may, at the option of the Editor(s), be given an opportunity to read and correct the copyedited manuscript, but if you fail to return it to the Editor(s) by the date set by the Editor(s), production and publication will proceed without your further correction.
5. You will receive one copy of the published Work and may purchase additional copies of the Work for your own use at a 40 percent discount from list price.

If the foregoing terms are satisfactory to you, please indicate your acceptance by signing and dating this Agreement below. One copy should be returned to the Editor(s). The other copy is for your files.
