

Review Units 1, 2, and 3

Suggestions for Use

- (1) Use the Review Unit as an in-class quiz to *pretest* student knowledge before beginning the three vocabulary units that precede each Review. Note the items that seem easy or difficult for students and plan your classroom instruction accordingly.
- (2) Use the Review Unit as an in-class test to *posttest* student knowledge after students have completed the three vocabulary units that precede each Review. Students may need more instruction or practice with items that they miss.
- (3) Assign these units as homework to help students review the vocabulary studied in the units.
- (4) Students may want to use these units on their own to review and test their knowledge of the vocabulary in the previous units.

Directions

- a. Go over the directions for each section with students to be sure they understand them. Give examples if necessary.
- b. If using the Review Unit as a test, be sure that you allow enough time for students to complete the exercises. Students should not use dictionaries or refer to their textbooks.
- c. Correct the Review Unit in class. Explain any items that students had problems with.
- d. Note that the answers for these units appear in the Answer Key in the student book.
