

## APPENDIX: BEN WEBSTER'S MUSICAL ACTIVITIES

### List of jobs, engagements, and recording sessions

Information listed here is not complete, of course. It is derived from various sources, among others *Down Beat*, *New Amsterdam News*, *Chicago Defender*, *Pittsburgh Courier*, *Metronome*, *Jazz Journal*, *Jazz Monthly*, *Melody Maker*, *Jazz Magazine* (Paris), *Jazz Podium*, *Orkester Journalen*, *Variety*, *Billboard*, local newspapers, programs from Jazzhus Montmartre (Copenhagen), and also from interviews. To fill the gaps I borrowed some data from Walter C. Allen, *Hendersonia* (Allen, 1973), Count Basie and Albert Murray, *Good Morning Blues* (Random House, 1985), Klaus Stratemann, *Duke Ellington: Day by Day and Film by Film* (JazzMedia, 1992) supplemented with new research by Kenneth R. Steiner, and Franz Hoffmann's most helpful compilations of *Jazz Advertised in the Negro Press, 1910-1967* (Hoffmann, 1980-89) and *Jazz Reviewed, 1910-50* (Hoffmann, 1995).
